Byerly Park track named in honor of Terrence Herrington.



In a resolution presented to Hartsville City Council on December 8, 2009, the competition running track at Byerly Park has been named in honor of **Terrence Herrington**. While at Hartsville High School in 1984, Mr. Herrington set and still holds the South Carolina high school record in the half-mile and mile runs. He also holds the Clemson University record for the 800, 1000, and 1500 meter runs and is a four-time NCAA all-American, five-time ACC Champion, and a member of the NCAA Championship relay team that set a world record for the 4 x 800 meter relay.

Herrington is a two-time USA National Champion in the 1500 meter run and competed in the 1992 Barcelona Olympics.
