A recent grant in the amount of \$23,423 has been awarded to the Hartsville Police Department by the Office of Justice Programs at the Department of Justice. This grant will be used to purchase a new police vehicle.

To date, the Hartsville Police Department has received grants from stimulus funds in the amount of \$388,753. This money has been allocated for K-9 units, computer equipment for detective division, SWAT shields, rifles and mounts, police cars, and officer salaries.
